

## The Race

The annual Head-of-the-Charles Regatta sponsored by the Cambridge Boat Club is patterned after the many English "Head-of-the-River" races. These make use of a tortuous course which not only puts the coxswain's steering to test but allows greater distances to challenge the rowers' endurance. By eliminating the need for qualifying races, head races also allow many more boats to compete in a given amount of time.

Although the contestants are rowing against time, spectators are witness to keen competition between boats which take running starts only 10 seconds apart. Boats are numbered consecutively so that it is easy to see their relative positions in each event. To avoid overlapping events at the finish, each event is started 15 to 30 minutes apart. Note that each boat is identified by a bow marker which corresponds to its number in the program.

Each shell in this Regatta will be timed over the race course by three distinct and separate timing systems. The primary system entails the timing (to 1/10 of a second) by computer terminals located at the starting line and at the finish line. These terminals are connected to a PDP-10 computer at ADP/First Data Corporation in Waltham, Massachusetts, where the results will be computed almost immediately. The primary backup system, in the event of power failure, uses precision digital stop watches. In addition there is a third system under trial this year using a Hewlett Packard 3000 computer.

The times from the computer will remain unofficial until the Regatta umpires have had an opportunity to report course rule violations and invoke time penalties, and until any protests received within 15 minutes after the end of each race have been resolved.

The boat winning an event is the Head of the River for that event the following year. The order of finish of the remaining boats determines their starting order the following year with the fastest competitors first. This reduces the amount of passing required and provides a great advantage to the leading boats which have clear water without washes.

## Its Origin

On a cold winter night in December, 1964 three members of the Cambridge Boat Club (Howard McIntyre, D'arcy MacMahon, and John Vincent) met with British rowing luminary Ernest Arlett to consider the possibility of initiating an annual rowing event on the Charles River in Boston, Massachusetts. The idea was to integrate scholastic and club rowing in a unique and informal way, and to promote the recreational and non-polluting use of the river. While an April date was given much consideration, the group finally decided to fill the void created by the lack of post-Labor Day competition and chose the Saturday nearest to the Columbus Day holiday. The idea of a "Head-of-the-River" race, patterned after the famous and successful English regatta, was unanimously adopted. It was felt that this type of race would minimize the emphasis on winning and losing, would accommodate a large number of competitors, and would avoid the wind and motor-boat disturbances of the open lower river basin.

With the sanction of the National Association of Amateur Oarsmen, the financial support of the Boston Globe, and the valiant efforts of many Cambridge Boat Club volunteers like Jerome Olrich and Zeus Wade, the first Head-of-the-Charles Regatta was held on October 16, 1965. The race drew nearly 100 boats and was an instant success with the public and rowers alike.

What has happened since is a matter of historical record. The Regatta has grown to become the largest in the World and now draws the very finest rowing talent from North America and beyond. In 1973, the Cambridge Boat Club officially took over the responsibility for managing the Regatta, and placed it under the trusteeship of three club members appointed annually by the Club's elected Board of Directors. The race's timing system has been transformed from a simple homemade clock-mechanism, to a sophisticated computerized electronic system. The program has expanded from twelve to eighteen events with a maximum of forty entries each, and the Regatta is now held annually on the next to last Sunday in October. In spite of its growth and seriousness of its competition, the Regatta continues to be a refreshingly informal and friendly affair.

It is only because of the unselfish efforts and endless hours of hundreds of unpaid volunteers that the Head-of-the Charles keeps going. All who row in it and all who watch it, owe these dedicated individuals a great debt of thanks. As long as the Regatta continues to provide a source of amusement and gratification to its administrators and volunteers from the surrounding community, we can be assured that the Charles, unlike its namesake Charles the First of England in 1649, will keep its Head.

## Timing the Race

Since 1970 a computer has been used to time the boats in the Head-of-the-Charles Regatta. Computer terminals are located at both the Start and Finish lines. These devices speak their own language into regular telephones which are connected to a central computer. These terminals are used to record the instant when each boat starts and finishes. The computer then follows its predetermined program and automatically calculates times over the course, makes adjustments for any handicap, rearranges the order of boats according to their times, and prints this information on paper. This way the results of each race are available within a minute after the finish.


This elaborate technique was developed because the river is narrow, only two boats wide in some places allowing for boats returning downstream, and because of the great popularity of the event. This year there are 720 boats with more than 3000 competitors on the water all racing against the clock.

The trick comes in timing all these boats to find out who won quickly and accurately. The calculations are even more difficult for the Veteran's Singles where a handicap is awarded of 8 seconds for each year that the competitor has aged over forty. In the early days of the regatta this was done with mechanical stop watches. These had "split" second hands that stopped with a push of a button but the watch kept on running to time the remaining boats. Before the regatta the stopwatches were synchronized so that the

starting time could be subtracted from the finish time to obtain the time for the course.

This was an extremely tedious process and delayed the production of the race results by several hours. It was accomplished by bringing the start and finish times to a central location by car or bicycle. Then a team of mathematicians subtracted all the differences to tenths of seconds, applied the handicaps, and sorted the adjusted times to give the order of finish. Needless to say it took several hours to figure out who won each event, by which time the regatta was over and everyone else had gone home.

By 1970 the regatta had grown to the point that stopwatch timing was almost impossible. Fortunately the technology of "time-sharing" computers had become available, invented in large part by President Kemeny of Dartmouth College. This allowed people in different locations to "talk" to the same computer (and at the same time since computers "talk" much faster than people). Another fortunate coincidence was the appearance of a corporate sponsor for the regatta in the form of ADP/First Data Corporation of Waltham who offered to provide time sharing computer services free of charge. Since 1970 the basis of the timing has been the computer, with the result that the unofficial race results are ready within a minute after the race is over. The official results cannot be issued until the Umpires have reported any rule violations and the Judges have ruled on any protests from the competitors.




## The Equipment




### SINGLES

Singles are boats about 26 feet long, 11 inches wide, and weighing some 30 pounds propelled by one person with two oars sometimes called sculls.




### DOUBLE SCULLS

Doubles are boats propelled by two people each with two oars (or sculls).




### PAIRS

Pair-oared boats are propelled by two people each with one oar sometimes called a sweep.



### FOURS


Four-oared boats have four rowers each with one oar and a coxswain to steer and cajole them.



### EIGHTS

Eight-oared boats have eight rowers each with one oar and they have a coxswain. The boat is about 60 feet long and weighs about 230 pounds.

## Trophies

Princeton Trophy is awarded to the fastest crew representing a secondary school.

After each event, points will be awarded to represented organizations for each finishing entry on the following basis:

P(E+1-F)      Key: P = points assigned to the event E = number of entries finishing the race F = finishing place of the entry R = finishing place of that entry relative to entries from same organization in that event

Trophies may be won by individual clubs, schools and colleges. Composite crews (representing more than one organization) may win medals only.

The Paul Revere Point Trophy is awarded to the organization with the most points for all its entries in the Regatta.  
Last year's winner: Harvard University, 712.7 points.

## History of Rowing

Oars have been used to propel water craft since ancient times but competitive rowing is believed to have had its origins in the races Thames River boatmen held among themselves four hundred years ago.

However, it was not until 1829 that rowing was introduced to the world of sport when crews from Oxford and Cambridge Universities competed in a race on the Thames between Putney and Mortlake on a course measuring 6,838 metres, the course that is still used by crews from the same universities in their annual classic.

Great Britain hosted the first international rowing event, the Royal Henley Regatta, which has been attracting the best crews since 1839.

Boats have been evolving through the ages and the craft used in the original competitions on the Thames were scarcely the trim craft we have today.

One change came in 1843 with the introduction of outriggers which enabled oarsmen to work their sweep oars in oarlocks extended from a narrow boat. That led to the slim boats used in modern competitions.

Then in 1856 came racing boats without keels, flat swift craft that could be propelled at much faster speeds. About the same time, oarsmen and scullers discovered the advantages of using their legs and sliding forward and backward as they rowed. At first they greased the panel on which they were sitting and sat on sheepskin. Sliding seats were introduced in 1871.

Other developments over the years came in the type of boats and oars. Sculls are those shorter oars used by single rowers with one for each hand. Sweep oars are longer and are used with both hands, so that the oarsmen alternate.

Britain continued as a world leader in the sport for nearly a century. Professional scullers from England and the British Empire taught all the leading countries of Europe how to scull and how to row in the years before the Second World War. It has been reported that there was no money available for their services in Britain so they went to the continent.

They were so successful in their teaching that the dominance in sculling and rowing shifted to the continent and in the 1936 Olympic Games in Berlin, Germans won five of the seven gold medals. Britain won only the double sculls.

In 1960 the German Ratzeburg eight, coached by Karl Adam, won the gold medal in the Rome Olympic Games and went on to dominate competition for years. The key was Adam's system of teaching rowing by placing emphasis on sculling training, small boat work and extensive weight training.

To scull successfully requires unremitting practice in all types of weather and preferably through the year. To build the necessary qualities requires running, weightlifting, and many miles of rowing. Oarsmen learn to set up the boat and to concentrate on balance, timing and the run of the boat. They learn also to relax during recovery, (between strokes).

Here's what the great Jack Beresford, the British Olympic gold medalist during the '20s and early '30s has to say:

"Fitness, determination, concentration and self-reliance have to be built into the crack sculler. Perfection or near perfection can only be achieved by mileage, hard-striding work in the winter months (including long stretches of firm paddling — 3 miles minimum without easing). One only learns to scull when tired. Doing only short pieces of work fails to show up lack of technique. It is essential to learn to scull distances before trying fast work."

"Sculling technique for sweep rowing is only a means to an end. Proficiency in a single sculler should not be the only means for the selection of a sweep oarsman, only a yard-stick."

"Bear in mind that to reach proficiency requires expert rigging and the right length of sculls as well as the right width of blades. Men vary in type, temperament and build; they need advice from an expert."





As an all-round sport, rowing suits about every temperament. It develops muscles and character as well as team spirit, because of the amount of disinterested effort it requires.
