The Race

On Sunday October 21, 1979, the historic Charles River will be the setting for the Fifteenth Annual Head-of-the-Charles Regatta. This festive gathering of rowers and spectators attracts a huge following each Fall. People come from all over the U.S. and Canada to compete or to watch. The competitors in the Head-of-the-Charles Regatta come from about 150 Colleges, Schools and Private Clubs. Incidentally, the "Head" of the Charles is the boat that wins the race.

There are eighteen different race events. Some races are for *single scullers*: one person with two oars. Other races are for *fours* and *eights*: in these larger boats each rower has only one oar. Some races are for "lightweights" while some are restricted on the basis of age. Veteran *scullers* must be at least 50 years old and they receive an eight-second handicap for each year over 50. Many *veterans* row in their 60's and 70's. Three of the races are exclusively for women.

Last year the Head-of-the-Charles introduced the *Mixed Eights*. In this race, according to one wit, four of the eight rowers in each boat "are of the opposite sex." Other regattas now include the *Mixed Eights*, making this event a bonafide part of the rowing calendar. This race was introduced as an experiment and has proved a huge success. The possibilities of this race can only be surmised. It clearly cuts across traditional views of competitive rowing. It will certainly help to clarify our understanding of the physiology and psychology of athletic activity. At the same time the race is a lot of fun. That is what the Head-of-the-Charles is all about!

"Head" Regattas

The Head-of-the-Charles is one of several "Head" regattas held in North America each fall. In "Head" regattas, despite the name, the boats do not race head-to-head. Rather they start one after the other at intervals of ten-to-fifteen seconds. In order to decide who wins, each boat is clocked over the course. Since the Head-of-the-Charles attracts 720 competing boats, the timing is performed by computer. Without this automation it would take people with stop-watches many hours of tedious work to figure out the winner and places in each event. As it is the results are available within a couple of minutes of the last boat crossing the finish line.

One of the big advantages of the "Head" style of racing is that there is a fairly continuous succession of boats passing by all day. This may be contrasted with head-to-head racing in which there are brief intervals of high excitement followed by lengthy waits for the next event. The Head-of-the-Charles is a veritable pageant of rowing in which the day is filled with boats rowing by. Over 3,000 rowers cover the course during the Regatta.

Watching the Race

Although the contestants are rowing against time, the many thousands of spectators along the course are witness to keen competition as the boats vie for position at bridge arches and sweeping river bends.

Each boat is fitted with a bow number indicating its starting order. Thus, during the race its relative position is readily apparent and enthusiastic, non-partisan applause will often accompany a boat observed to be well ahead of its starting position.

Spectators can be found along the entire length of the course with crowds at many bridge and river-bend locations (see map). The progress of each race and the unofficial order of finish are announced by loudspeaker at the finish line. Attractive programs listing the competitors' names are available along the course on race day.

Prizes

Handsome trophies are presented to winning clubs in most events. Sculptured bronze medals are awarded to all competitors taking the first five places in every event. The *Princeton Trophy* will go the fastest boat representing a secondary school. The *Paul Revere Point Trophy* will be awarded to the organization amassing the greatest number of "points" in the overall Regatta.

Its Origin

On a winter night in December, 1964 three members of the Cambridge Boat Club (Howard McIntyre, D'Arcy MacMahon, and John Vincent) met with British rowing luminary Ernest Arlett to consider the possibility of initiating an annual rowing event on the Charles River. The hope was to integrate College, School and Club rowing in a unique and informal way, and to promote the recreational and non-polluting use of the river. The idea of a "Head-of-the-River" race, patterned after the famous and successful English regatta, was unanimously adopted. It was felt that this type of race would minimize the emphasis on winning and losing, would accommodate a large number of competitors, and would avoid the wind and motorboat disturbances of the lower river basin.

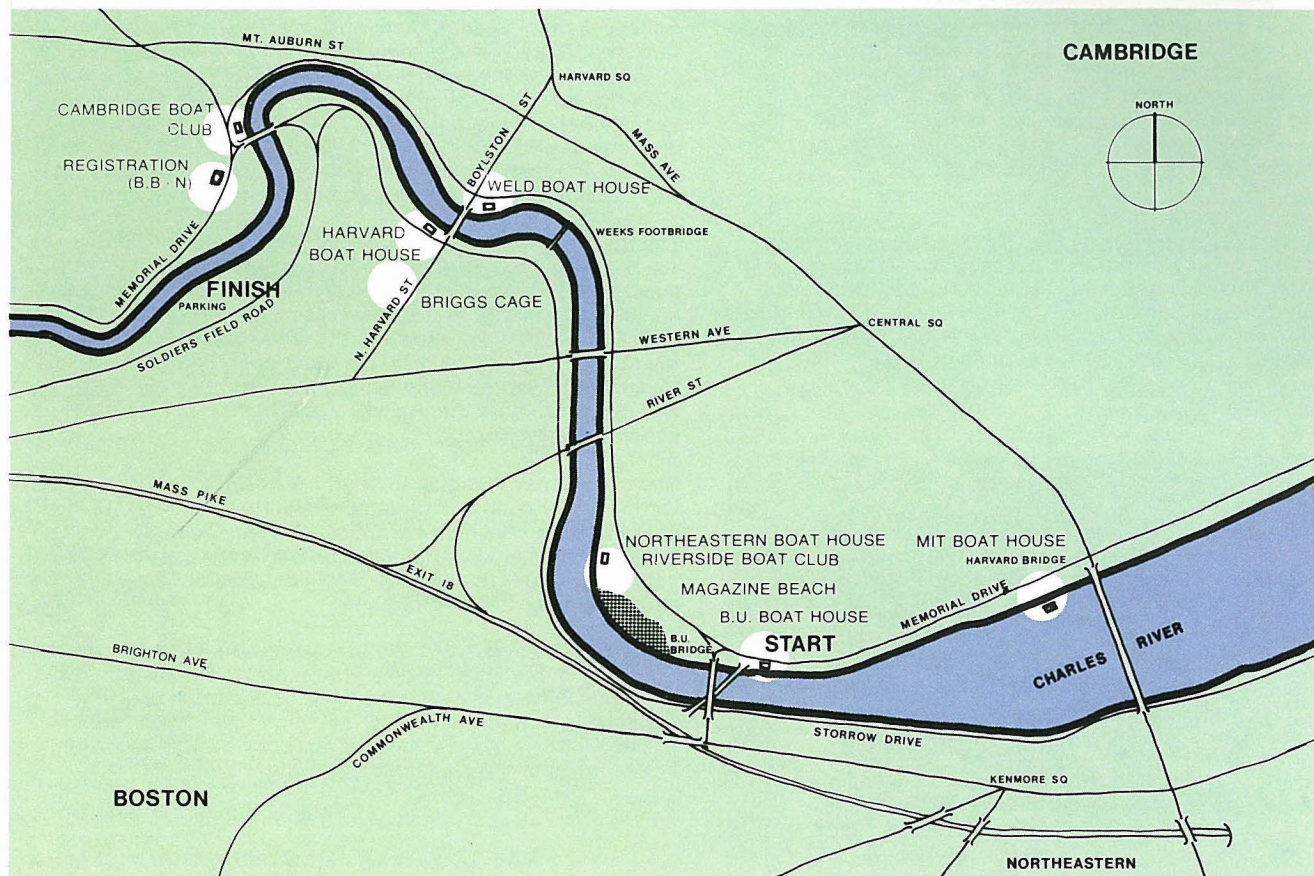
The first Head-of-the-Charles Regatta was held on October 16, 1965. The race drew nearly 100 boats and was an instant success with the public and rowers alike. What has happened since is a matter of historical record. The Regatta has grown to become the largest in the world and draws the finest rowing talent. In 1973, the Cambridge Boat Club officially took over the responsibility for managing the Regatta and placed it under the trusteeship of three club members appointed annually.

Needless to say it is only through the unselfish efforts and long hours of hundreds of unpaid volunteers that the Head-of-the-Charles becomes a reality each year. Over 130 "official" volunteers from the ranks of the Cambridge Boat Club plus an unknown number of friends and acquaintances were responsible for the 1978 Regatta.

In spite of its growth and the seriousness of its competition, the Regatta continues to be a festive and friendly affair. It is now scheduled each year for the next-to-last Sunday in October when the crisp air, vibrant autumn foliage and furious activity on the water combine to present New England with one of its most colorful sporting events.

 1856 First shell construction, i.e., a frame with a lightweight skin of wood, to replace barges and lapstreaks
 1857 J. C. Babcock of Nassau Boat Club, New York, invents the sliding seat and uses it in his single
 1857 Schuylkill Navy formed to regulate American regattas
 1869 Babcock of New York built a six with sliding seats, first sweep boat so equipped; rowed in the Hudson Amateur Rowing Association Regatta
 1872 National Association of Amateur Oarsmen (NAAO) formed with first national championships in 1873
 1872 Paper-skinned boats constructed by Waters of Troy, N.Y.
 1874 Mike Davis, U.S. professional sculler and coach invented first swivel oarlock and also nonsymmetrical blades on oars (the "leg of mutton" blades)
 1876 Harvard-Yale annual race inaugurated, won by Yale
 1876 First international amateur regatta in U.S. was held as part of the Centennial Exposition in Philadelphia. Crews from England and Ireland took part but American crews won all six events.
 1878 Columbia became first American college to row at Henley winning the Visitors' Cup, in a paper shell
 1885 Oxford crew rowed across English Channel in 4 hours, 22 minutes
 1897 Edward Hanlon Ten Eyck, Wachusett Boat Club of Worcester, was first American to win the Diamond Sculls at Henley, setting a record for the course of 8:35
 1900 Olympic Regatta established; U.S. (Vesper Boat Club) wins gold medal in eight. Ten Eyck refuses to go when NAAO will not pay for the expenses of his coach.
 1920 John Kelly (U.S.) wins gold medal in single at Olympics, the second and last sculler for U.S. to do so; his entry at Henley is refused
 1926 Head of the River Race inaugurated in England
 1947 Jack Kelly, Jr. (U.S.) wins Diamond Sculls at Henley, and again in 1949.
 1953 Peregrine Pollen sculled a mile, ran a mile, and rode a mile in under 14 minutes at Oxford
 1954 European Championships for women established; Russia wins all five events
 1960 West Germany wins eight at Olympics, marking the beginning of German resurgence in rowing. In previous 12 Olympics, U.S. had won 10 golds in the eight, England the other 2.
 1964 Sy Cromwell (U.S.) wins Diamond Sculls at Henley, and is first sculler to break 8 minutes in the history of the regatta.
 1965 Don Spero (U.S.) wins Diamond Sculls at Henley and sets new record for course
 1965 Head of the Charles Regatta founded
 1966 East Germany competes separately from West Germany for the first time in the World Championships at Bled; wins gold in coxless pair, coxless four, and coxed four; West Germany wins eight.
 1972 U.S. eight wins one medal in Olympics, a silver in the eight; this year also marks the beginning of the use of an official camp system in the U.S.
 1975 U.S. women win silver medal in eight in World Championships, first medal ever
 1976 First Olympic rowing events for women; U.S. women win silver in single (Joan Lind) and bronze in eight.

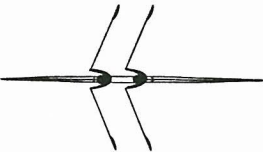


The Equipment



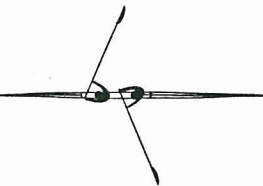
SINGLES

Singles are boats about 26 feet long, 11 inches wide, and weighing some 30 pounds propelled by one person with two oars sometimes called sculls.



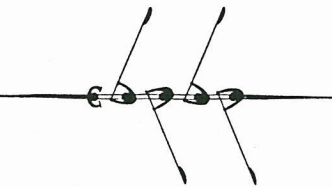
DOUBLE SCULLS

Doubles are boats propelled by two people each with two oars (or sculls).



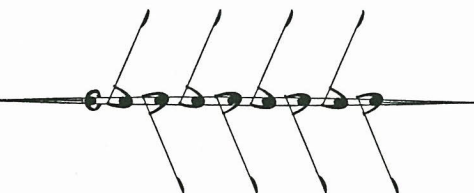
PAIRS

Pair-oared boats are propelled by two people each with one oar sometimes called a sweep.



FOURS

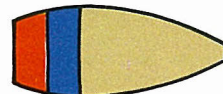
Four-oared boats have four rowers each with one oar and a coxswain to steer and cajole them.



EIGHTS

Eight-oared boats have eight rowers each with one oar and they have a coxswain. The boat is about 60 feet long and weighs about 230 pounds.
