



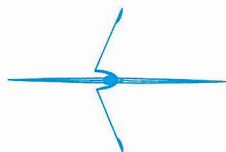

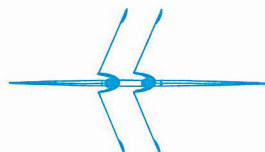

The Equipment



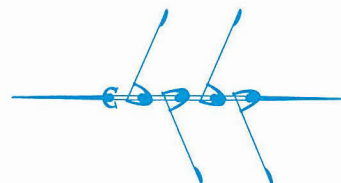
SINGLES

Singles are boats about 26 feet long, 11 inches wide, and weighing some 30 pounds, propelled by one person with two oars sometimes called sculls.



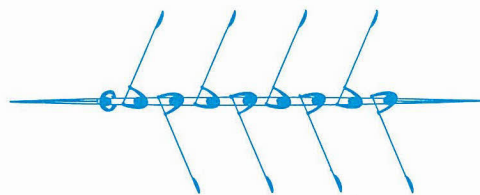
DOUBLE SCULLS

Doubles are boats propelled by two people, each with two oars (or sculls).



FOURS

Four-oared boats have four rowers, each with one oar and a coxswain to steer and cajole them.



EIGHTS

Eight-oared boats have eight rowers, each with one oar, and they have a coxswain. The boat is about 60 feet long and weighs about 230 pounds.

Paul Revere Trophy

The Paul Revere Trophy is awarded to the organization with the most points for all its finishing entries in the Regatta on the following basis:

$$\text{Point awarded to each entry} = \frac{P(E+1-F)}{ER}$$

where:

P = points assigned to the event

E = number of entries finishing the race

F = finishing place of that entry

R = finishing place of that entry relative to others from the same organization in that event

Last year's winner: **Princeton University, 264.7 points**

EVENT QUALIFICATIONS

- **Youth crews** are composed of persons under 19 years old.
- **Club single** scullers (see Club crews below)
- **Master** scullers are at least 30 years old.
- **Senior master** scullers are at least 40 years old.
- **Veteran** scullers are at least 50 years old and receive an age handicap of eight seconds per year.
- **Lightweights** are male scullers and crews averaging under 160 pounds and female scullers and crews averaging under 125 pounds.
- **Club** crews and scullers are composed of persons who, in the current calendar year, did not finish in the top six places in any elite or open event at any national rowing championships or national team trials.
- **Fours** and **Eights** are all "with coxswain."

In the Beginning

The Head-of-the-Charles Regatta was established following a meeting in December, 1964 between its founding directors, Howard McIntyre, D’Arcy MacMahon and British rowing luminary Ernest Arlett, when it was resolved (as it was similarly at Henly-on-Thames in 1839):

“That from the lively interest which has been manifested at the various boat races which have taken place on the Charles River over the years, this meeting is of the opinion that the establishing of an annual regatta, under judicious and respectable management, would not only be productive of the most beneficial results to the City of Cambridge and the City of Boston, but from its peculiar attractions would also be a source of amusement and gratification to the neighborhood and to the public in general.”

The hope was to integrate College, School and Club rowing in a unique and informal way. The idea of a “Head-of-the-River” race, patterned after the famous and successful English regatta, was adopted.

The first Head-of-the-Charles Regatta was held on October 16, 1965. The race drew nearly 100 boats and was an instant success with the public and rowers alike. What has happened since is a matter of historical record. The Regatta has grown to become the largest single day Regatta in the world. In 1973, the founders turned the responsibility for managing the Regatta over to the Cambridge Boat Club which placed it under the trusteeship of three Club members appointed annually by the Club’s Board of Directors.

Needless to say it is only through the unselfish efforts and long hours of hundreds of unpaid volunteers that the Head-of-the-Charles becomes a reality each year. Over 150 members of the Cambridge Boat Club plus an unknown number of friends and acquaintances were responsible for the Regatta last year.

In spite of its growth and the seriousness of its competition, the Regatta continues to be a festive and friendly affair. It is now scheduled each year on the next-to-last Sunday in October when the crisp air, vibrant autumn foliage and furious activity on the water combine to present New England with one of its most colorful sporting events.

How the Race is Run

There are 18 separate events in the Regatta, many of which include both a men’s division and a women’s division. Each event has 40 entries, resulting in a total of 720 boats in the entire Regatta.

Each event starts in the Charles River Basin downstream from the Boston University Bridge where 40 shells arrange themselves in assigned numerical order. At the direction of the Chief Starter the shells proceed to cross an electronically computerized starting line at about 15 second intervals and race three miles to the finish line near the WBZ studios, about a half mile beyond the Eliot Bridge.

Once all 40 shells in an event have crossed the finish line, starting times are automatically subtracted from the finishing times and the results for each event/division instantly produced. These results remain **unofficial** until later in the day when the Umpires posted along the course report any interference disqualifications or course/buoy violations.

Watching the Races

Although the contestants are rowing against time, the many thousands of spectators along the course are witness to keen competition as the boats vie for position at bridge arches and sweeping river bends.

Spectators can find prime viewing spots on bridges and at crucial corners along the course. (See Map) The locations provide the best vantage point for watching the developing strategies of the boats as they pass by. Accidental contact between the boats is inevitable but sportsmanship usually prevents severe collisions.

Each boat is fitted with a bow number indicating its starting order. Thus, during the race its relative position is readily apparent and enthusiastic, non-partisan applause will often accompany a boat observed to be well ahead of its starting position.

Computer terminals will be placed at the finish line, Magazine Beach and several boathouses. The operator will be able to retrieve the finishing order and times in any event within minutes of its completion.

“Head” Regattas

The Head-of-the-Charles is the largest of the several “Head” regattas held in North America each fall and being the oldest, is (like the Cheyenne Frontiers Day Rodeo) sometimes referred to as the “Daddy of ‘em all.”

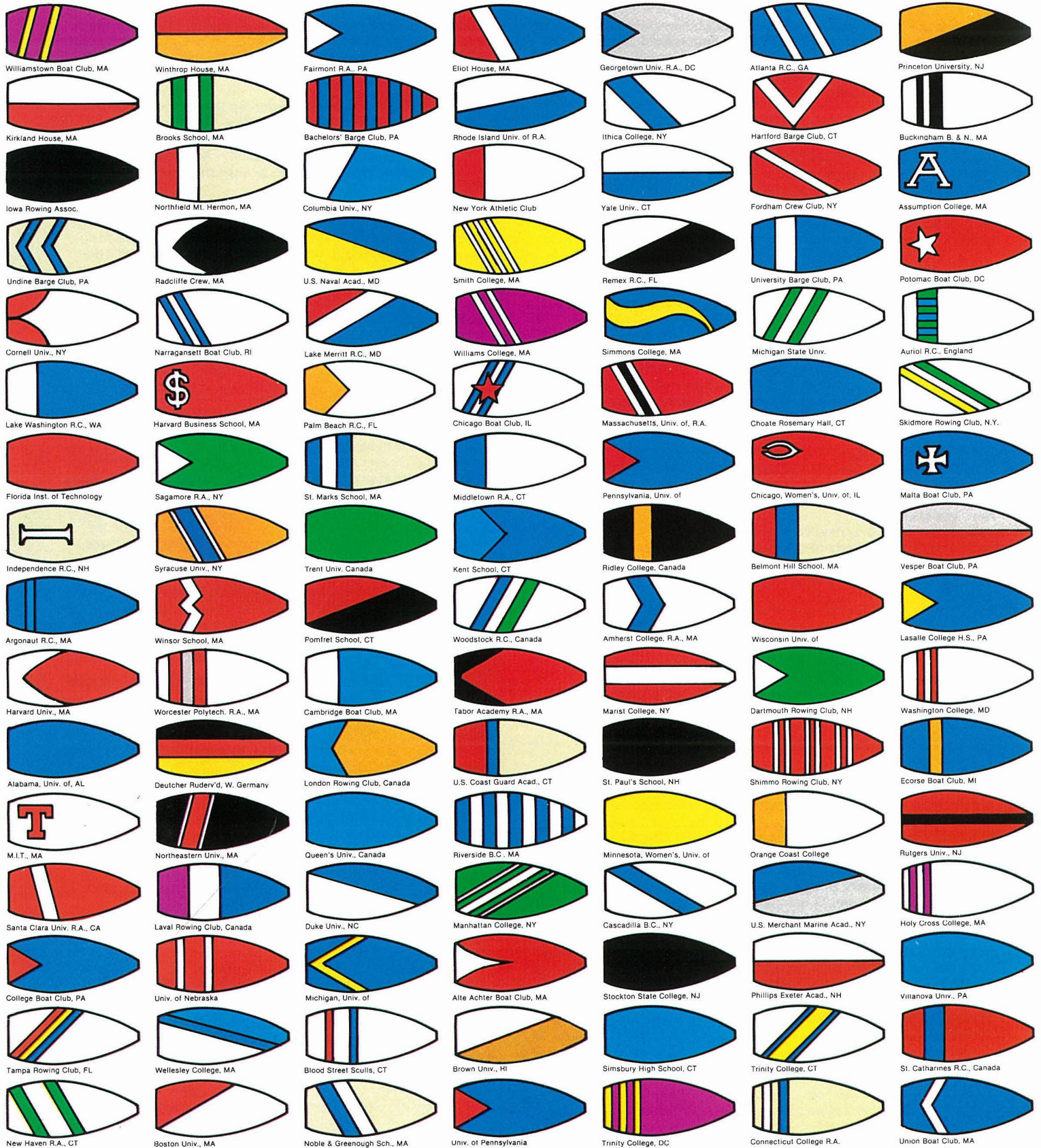
The Regatta derives its name from the fact that the winner of each event/division is officially crowned the “Head” of the Charles River for the ensuing year for that particular class.

One of the big advantages of the “Head” style of racing is that there is a fairly continuous succession of boats passing by all day. This may be contrasted with side by side racing, in which there are brief intervals of high excitement followed by lengthy waits for the next event. The Head-of-the-Charles is a veritable pageant of rowing in which the day is filled with boats rowing by. Over 3,000 rowers cover the course during the Regatta.

Prizes

Trophies are presented to winning clubs in most events. Sculptured bronze medals are awarded to the top competitors in every event. The *Princeton Trophy* will go to the highest placing schoolboy crew representing a secondary school. The *Princeton Cup Trophy* will go to the highest placing schoolgirl crew representing a secondary school. The *Paul Revere Point Trophy* will be awarded to the organization amassing the greatest number of “points” in the overall Regatta.
