

This year we will watch over 5,500 competitors from all over the United States, Canada, and the world compete fiercely and fairly as they race the (continued on page 6)



As Canadian crews collected medal after medal, the question began to circulate through the Awards' Tent: What is the secret of Canadian success in Boston?

By American standards, rowing in Canada follows a peculiar calendar. A generally cold climate necessitates short fall and spring seasons. Oddly, the Canadian college racing season is usually over just about the same time the U.S. sea-

son is beginning, and the Head marks the end of fall racing for most Canadian crews while American squads continue competing into late-November. For Canadians, an appearance on the awards float at Canadian Henley remains the Holy Grail and as a result most clubs in Canada schedule their entire race year to peak for the second

weekend in August.

For Canadian national team rowers, the summer is composed of training camps and trips to Europe, but races on home soil are rare. With few opportunities to race at home and the cold winds of winter beginning to show themselves, Boston's Head has become the best available forum at which to perform. As 1997 Women's Championship Single winner Maria Maunder said, "It's nice to go down to the States and show everyone what we've got."

Maunder said that her win in '97 could be attributed to

several things, including the race's late date and her long drive down from Canada.


"It's good to have a regatta at the end of the fall season. That pretty much wraps it up for us in Canada, there's no more water time after that so it's nice to have that to work for after the World Championships," said Maunder, who rowed for Canada in the quad at the 1997 World Championships and won a silver medal in the eight at the Atlanta Olympics. "I think that perhaps we go down there and it is a big trip for us and perhaps for other people it's not as big a deal. We have to drive 12 hours to get

there so it's important that we do well."


Canadian Women's coach AlMorrow said that the carry-over effect from a long summer of hard training seems to work well for his boats. Indeed, both the men's and women's lightweight singles winners, Lain Brambell and Laurie Featherstone, represented Canada at the '97 Worlds in France.

"I think in some events we're pretty focused on having the best national combos together, so obviously we

have an advantage," said Morrow. "In the women's eight [in 1997] we had the top boat we could put on the water at that point. So that gives us good advantage. We came off a successful Worlds and . . . I don't think the women trained particularly hard in the fall, I think there was just that residual carry over of fitness and they were all happy to see each other and









[but] they threw the boat on the water together once."

But for Morrow, who has guided Canada's women to an enviable international record over the past seven years, the best way to success is often the simplest. "If you look at crews who do well they're just a little more organized.

"I don't know if it's knowing the course, because certainly a lot of the crews that go down there are really familiar with it. I think it's just a race we really enjoy. I find going there is really relaxing, it's nice to see your fellow international competitors and compete on [a]

level where you're not so nervous as [one can be at] the Worlds."

"So we've always gone down feeling really good and looking forward to Boston and I think that's probably why we tend to do well. I think the year before when



"It was a special race, because we knew it was sort of the swan song of our eight from the summer," said lightweight eight four-man Ben Storey. "We knew there probably wouldn't be an eight the next year and we're such a good bunch of friends that we really went out there and did it. It was such a pleasure to row,





because a lot of us hadn't been in a boat in a while, I had been rowing for my university and rowing at not quite the same level as at the World Championships."

The only fly in the ointment came when one member of the crew said he was suffering from such bad

tendonitis that he could not feather the oar and would be unable to row in Boston, "We were so excited to row that we were like 'Forget it. you're rowing," said Storey. The rower in question raced the entire three-mile course without feathering the blade, but the Canadian Lightweights prevailed nonetheless.

While the elites certainly defined the weekend for the Canadian crews, the list of events in which Canada triumphed ranged widely. On one end of the age spectrum, Scott Matthews and Kari Jurakko swooped down from Ontario to

beat Boston legends Greg Stone and Tiff Wood in the Masters Double, while in the Youth category the St. Catharines Junior Girls set a new course record in winning the Youth Eight race. Perhaps the specter of a long winter filled with ergometer sessions and days of watching the water freeze provided the extra incentive for Canadian rowers to excel in Boston.


"It's a fall motivator," said Al Morrow. "It's a way of

keeping the program focused and motivated." "It's sort of the end of the season," said Storev, "but it also sets [us] up for the winter training and lets people who are serious [achieve] something they can leap forward from for the rest of the winter. It's definitely worth it. It's so much fun."

While winning is certainly fun, the question arises: Will Canada ever repeat the success of 1997?

Although the level of Canadian rowing has shown no signs of tail-

ing off in the past year, the maple leaf has become a bulls-eye for crews who want pace boats to aim for. All the winners from '97 will race the Charles in '98 as favorites and it is always easier to win something the first time than defend a title.



EVENT SPECIFICATIONS

Club: Limited to persons (including coxswains) who in any sculling or sweep-oared event ("master" or "veteran" events excepted) DID NOT: A. Compete since 1994 in any world championships or Olympic Games; B. Earn a medal (Special Medals excepted) in the 1997 Head Of The Charles® regatta; C. In 1998: Reach the quarter-finals of the Henley Royal or Henley Women's Regattas, OR finish among the top six places in any national team trials, national or international championships (e.g. FISA World Cup, USRowing National Champs, Pan Ams, Lucerne, etc.), San Diego CC, EARC or EAWRC Sprints, PCRC, NCAA, PAC-10, IRA, or Canadian Henley Regattas, OR finish among the top three places in the Dad Vail or Champion International Collegiate Regattas.

Senior Veteran: At least 70 years old.

Veteran: At least 60 years old. Grand Master: At least 50 years old. Senior Master: At least 40 years old. Master (singles): At least 30 years old.

Master (crew): Rowers' ages average at least 40 years,

no one except coxswain under 30 years old.

Master 50+: Rowers' ages average at least 50 years, no one except coxswain under 30 years old.

Youth: Persons (coxswain included) under 20 years old and not yet in their sophomore (2nd) year of college/university.

High School: A crew composed entirely of students under 19 years old from a single High School.

Lightweight (singles): Maximum weights: Men: 160 lbs. Women: 130 lbs.

Lightweight (crew): Men: Average of rowers' weights not to exceed 160 lbs., no one over 170 lbs.

Women: Average of rowers' weights not to exceed 130 lbs., no one over 138 lbs.

Championship: Open (unrestricted).

Men's divisions: Male rowers and scullers only.

Women's divisions: Female rowers and scullers only.

Coxswains: May be of either sex, but must carry sufficient weight on them in the boat to weigh at least 100 lbs. during entire race (no weigh-in).

Fours and Eights: Sweep-oared, with coxswain. Singles and Doubles: Sculling, no coxswain.

Peggy Hawes Cup: Presented to the winner of the Women's Club Singles in honor of Margaret E. M. Hawes, inspiring founder of the Cambridge Boat Club's children's rowing program.

Olrich Bowl: Presented to the winner of the Men's Veteran Singles in memory of Jerome Olrich, twelve-time Head Of The Charles winner and key participant in the Regatta's development.

Wade Trophy: Presented to the highest placing Men's Senior Veteran in memory of Leonard "Zeus" Wade, key contributor to early Head Of The Charles regattas and long-time Senior Veteran standout.

Witte Trophy: Presented to the highest placing Women's Senior Veteran singles in memory of Edward and Eleanor Witte, beloved senior rowing members of the Cambridge Boat Club.

MDC Cup: Presented to the most competitive (percent behind the winner)
Massachusetts high school crew by the
Commissioner of the Metropolitan District
Commission.

Mowatt Cup: Presented to the winner of the Men's Grand Master Singles in memory of H.H. "Mo" Mowatt, long time friend of the Head Of The Charles. Coleman Cup: Presented to the winner of the Men's Lightweight Fours in memory of Charles Coleman, inspiring lightweight rower at St. Paul's and Yale and early supporter of the Head Of The Charles."

City of Cambridge Cup: Presented to the winner of the Women's Lightweight Fours by the Mayor of the City of Cambridge.

Boston Herald Cup: Presented to the winner of the Men's Lightweight Eights by the publisher of the Boston Herald.

Boston Cup: Presented to the winner of the Women's Lightweight Eights by the Mayor of the City of Boston.

Arlett Cup: Presented to the winner of the Men's Lightweight Singles in honor of George Ernest Arlett, key advisor to the founders of the Head Of The Charles.

Singer Cup: Presented to the winner of the Women's Lightweight Singles in honor of Edward Singer, the starting line "voice" of the Head Of The Charles for its first 20 years.

Cromwell Trophy: Presented to the winner of the Men's Championship Double in memory of Seymour Cromwell, national and international sculling champion and member of the Cambridge Boat Club.







The tireless and conscientious efforts of these 12 individuals cannot be underestimated. Without their focus and inspiration the Regatta would not remain the beacon for all Head races that is has become. In closing, the important and visionary leadership of the Regatta is managed by Cambridge Boat Club elders. 




