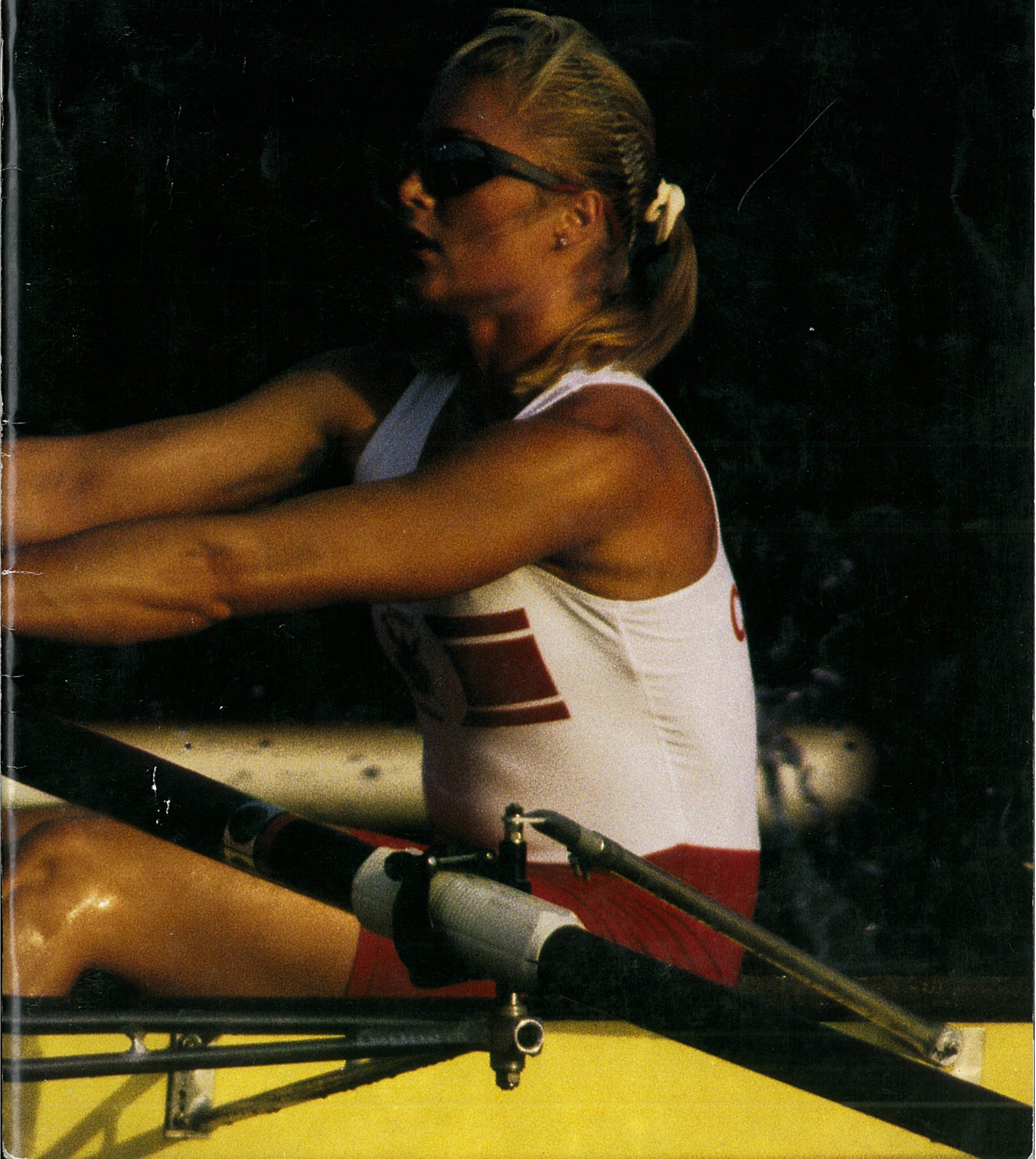

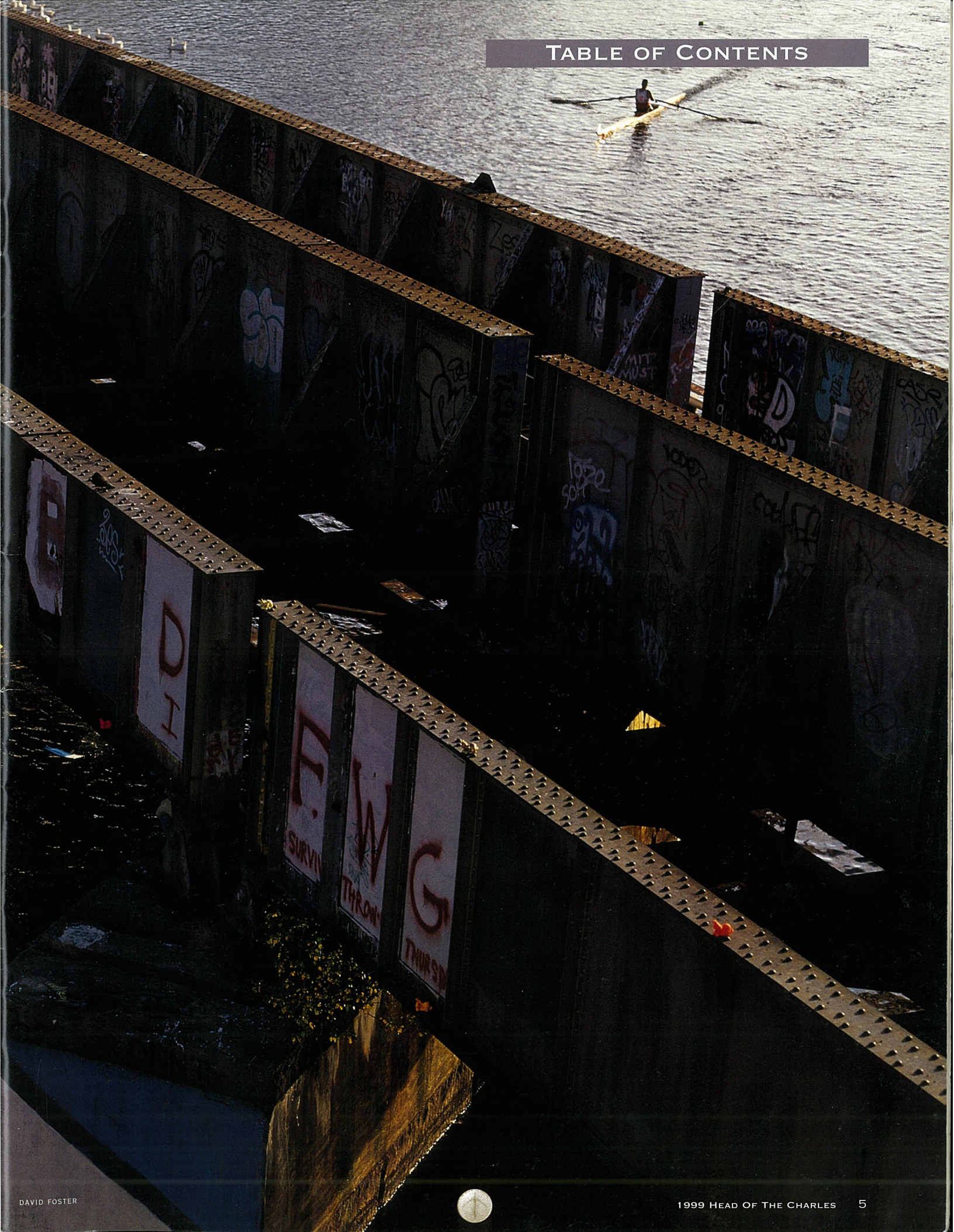

# LET BATTLE C

**T**he final shots of the 1999 racing campaign, or the opening salvo in the battle for glory in 2000? The Head of the Charles Regatta sits right on the cusp of the racing season. For many clubs it is the last chance to show off their speed before ice and winter weather close in. But for the near-professional athletes of the international scene, the Head of the Charles is their first serious assault on a gold medal in Sydney, eleven months from now. Time to show their domination. Time to psych out the opposition.

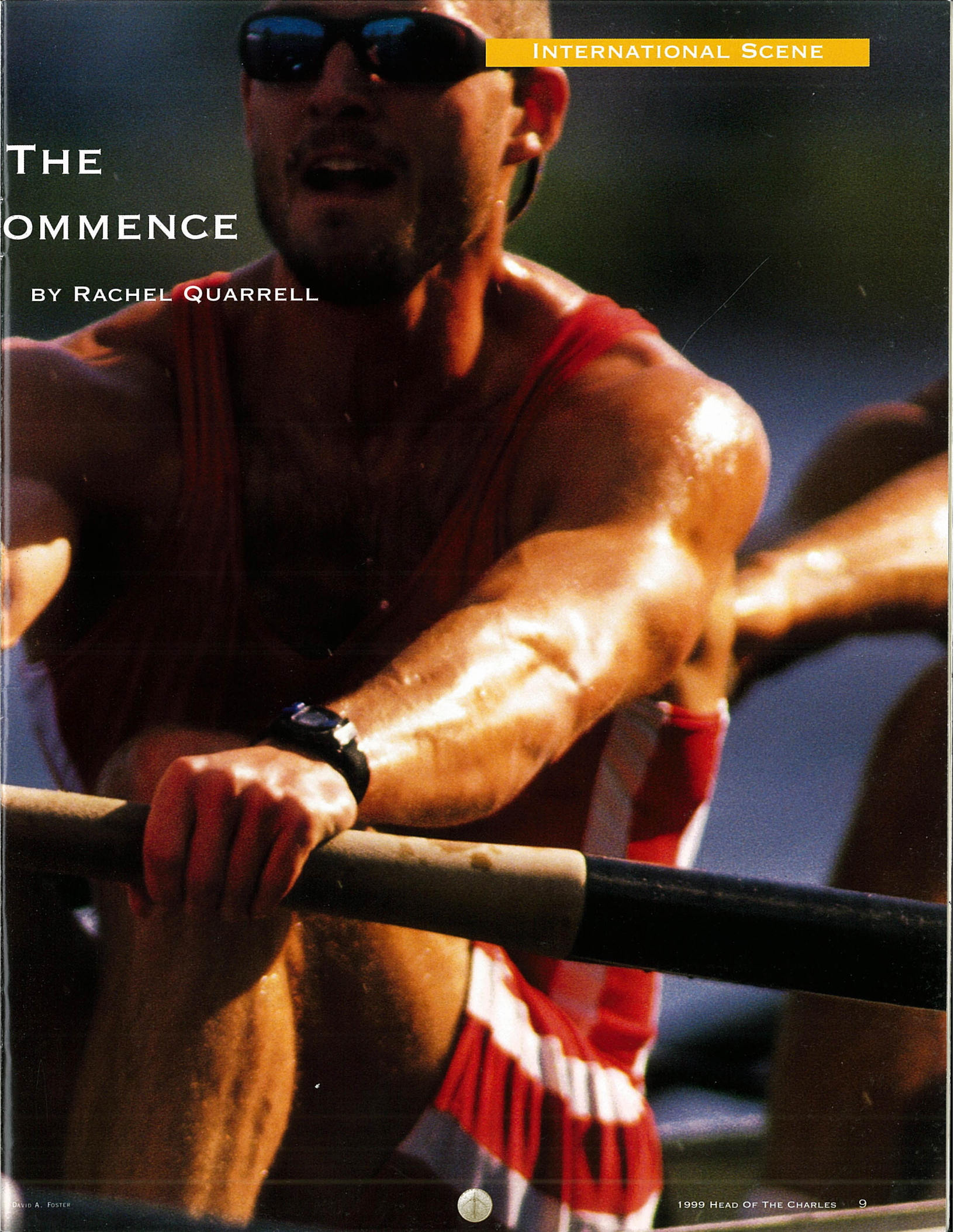
Nowhere is this more apparent than in the single sculls. For the first time, The Head Of The Charles is expanding the Championship Single events to include recruited international competitors and top US

scullers. These athletes participated in the 1999 World Championships, placed in the top six at US singles trials, and/or medalled last year in the Championship Single.

The Women's International Singles have a large entry. Leslie Burns-Rawley from the USA is joined by her fellow Worlds 1999 B-finalists: Australian Gina Douglas, Gaelle Buniet of France and Brit Alison Mowbray. Latvian C finalist Sanita Ozolijna makes her first appearance on the Charles, and Canadian multi-medalist Marnie McBean, with two World Cup medals and an Olympic qualifying place already in the bag, will be hard to beat.

The International Men's Singles are also competitive. Reigning champion and local hero

Jamie Koven will be using all his expert knowledge and training to hold off Slovenia's Luka Spik, Estonia's Juri Jaanson, Dutchman Merlin Vervoorn,

and Latvia's Andris Reinholds. Reinholds has competed in the past four World Championships and in the 1996 Olympics. His first two years on the Latvian team were as a member of their men's 2x, with the last three as the single representative.

Three years ago, Vervoorn won the Henley Diamond Sculls and then turned down the Olympic spare place to go to the Under-23's instead, saying "I go to row, not to watch." He is now in the quadruple sculls. Koven went one better, adding the 1997 world title to his Diamonds Cup, and this year claimed the last Sydney qualifying spot in Canada. Come-back kid

Jaanson is not only a former world

champion, but until 1999 held the world's fastest single's time over 2 km and now ranks seventh in the world. Luka Spik has successfully played musi-

cal boats with Iztok Cop all year. The duo won three 1x World Cup medals and combined to hook a gold in the M2x in Vienna, followed by the World double title in St. Catharines.

The Championship Eights are also being contested internationally: a three-way face-off in both men's and women's categories with the top US clubs hot on their heels. Last year the Danish women's eight led the Canadians and Americans home, and all three crews return for the rematch. This year at World's the Americans won the silver, the Canadians won the bronze, and the Danes came in fifth.

Last year the US men's eight dominated the Charles, but their masterful third gold medal in St. Catharines has thrown down the gauntlet.

Taking up the challenge are the German men, Henley Royal champions, but tenth in the world. Also in the race is Canada, who just missed

Olympic qualification to come eighth in front of their home crowd this summer. The British will join in, as well, with an eight comprised of current National team members and Olympic hopefuls, including Greg Searle, the British sculler.

But as you watch the smooth bladework and awesome power of these international rowers slide past you, don't forget the crews behind. This year the Head of the Charles is playing host to crews from over twenty countries. In 1998 just two trophies departed overseas, and another four crossed the border to Canada. The tourists are on a mission this

entries will have to work hard to defend their silverware.



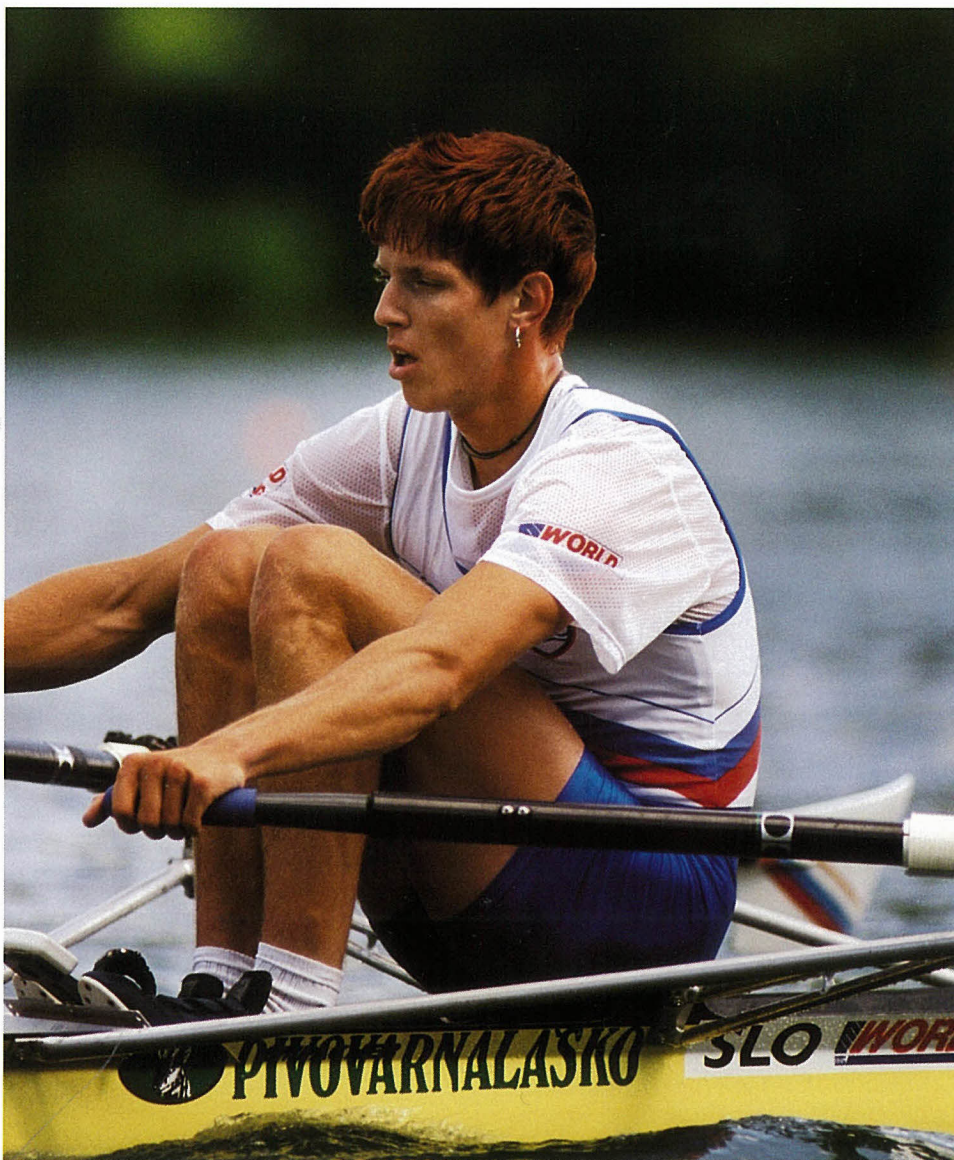
In the Youth events, last year dominated by American schools, only a handful of challengers make the journey. Westminster School from London, UK, will be looking to improve on last year's tenth position, while Ruderverein Emscher makes their first appearance from Germany.

Westminster will have to mind their steering - after a disastrous crash into Temple Island at Henley Women's Regatta in June, they will be hoping a different cox can make the grade at the tricky Eliot Turn.

The Master Men's overseas entry is more enthusiastic, perhaps because so many clubs now have alumni living in the US. Circolo Canottieri Tevere Remo boat club, which hails from the snaking Tiber in Rome, with in sight of St. Peter's Square and near the ancient Pantheon will

be racing. They can boast Italian ex-internationals amongst their coxswains and oarsmen, so will not be shy of taking on the competition. From the UK, the name Crabtree Boat Club hides a clutch of ex-Cambridge University Light Blues, while their

Oxford counterparts, more blatantly named, also enter. The Dark Blues will be racing for Varsity pride, a month after their historic boathouse on the banks of the river Isis was burnt to the ground, with the loss of many irreplaceable nineteenth-century oars and memorabilia.

Scullers' School - not really an academic institution, but a public club who train on the Boat Race course in London. The Scullers walked off with the Men's Club Eights trophy last time, and have brought almost their entire membership across the Atlantic in an attempt to recapture that title and perhaps add more

men's and women's medals to it. The Club Men's Eights is also hugely popular with Irish crews, including the Garda Siochana, home to the athletes amongst the Irish police force. It is a pity that the Cairo Police are not making the journey this year. Mixing it with

the Americans and Canadians in the club events are also youngsters Club Aviron ECSP from France, Het Spaarne from the Netherlands, and Mannheimer RuderClub von 1875.

The singles draws go further afield, with entries in the light and heavy women and men from Italy, Bulgaria, Belgium, the Czech Republic and the UK. A Turkish sculler from Galatasaray Sports Club (GSC) defies the havoc wrought in his country by the recent earthquake to make the journey. GSC train on the unusual Alibeykoy Dam near Istanbul, which is a 6.5 km long reservoir, but whose depth rises and falls with the water needs of the surrounding population.

The double sculls have the furthest visitors- women from Star Boating Club in New Zealand. Leander, UK, is entered in the men's dou-

bles, avoiding the rebuilding of their famous Pink Palace boathouse on the Thames. They are joined by crews from all over Europe, including AVK

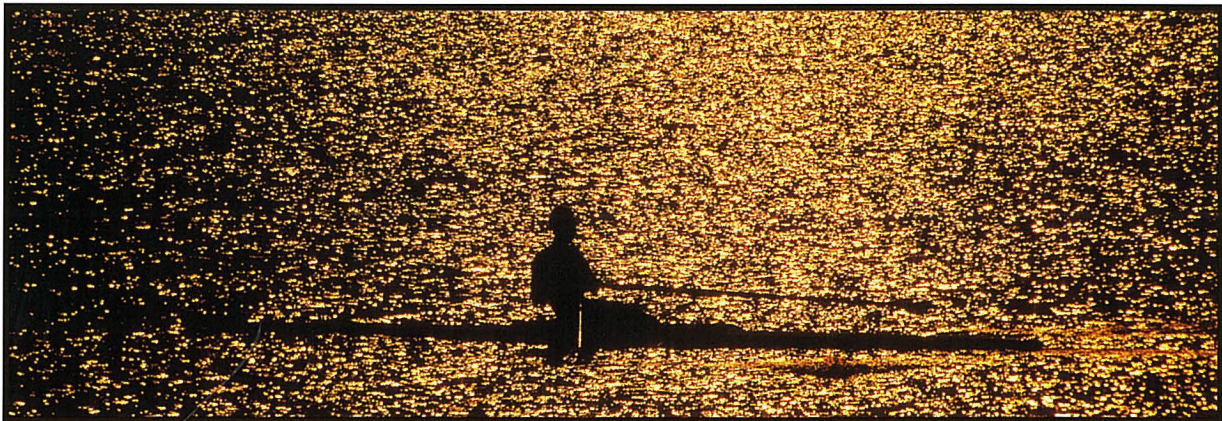
Mladost, from Zagreb (the 2000 World Championship site), and the famous Hamburger und Germania Ruder Club - the oldest club in Germany.

Take these crews, add a brew of competitive American rowing talent, and sprinkle generously with assorted Canadian entries. The 1999 Head of the Charles looks set to be a recipe for success and a celebration of rowing. You'll be seeing victors from the past, golden winners of the present, and more. Somewhere in the flood of blades and faces, sweeping past Magazine Beach and blasting through

Weeks Bridge, are the champions of the future. Don't forget to watch.

## EVENT SPECIFICATIONS

**Club:** Limited to persons (including coxswains) who in ANY sculling or sweep-oared event ("master" or "veteran" events excepted) DID NOT: A. Earn any Sr. World Championship or Olympic gold/silver/bronze medal or a 1st place medal in any Championship (open) event of the Head Of The Charles® Regatta; B. Compete in any Sr. World Championships or Olympic Games since 1993; C. Earn a medal ("Special Medals" excepted) in the 1998 Head of the Charles® Regatta; D. In 1999 Reach the quarter-finals of the Henley Royal or Henley Women's Regattas, OR finish among the top six places in any Nat'l team trials, Nat'l or Int'l championships (e.g. FISA World Cup, USRowing Nat'l champs, Pan Ams, Lucerne, FISA Jr. Worlds, FISA World Masters, Head Of The River, London, etc.), San Diego CC, EARC or EAWRC Sprints, PCRC, NCAA, PAC-10, IRA, or Canadian Henley (including intermediate level), OR finish among the top three places in the Dad Vail or Champion Int'l Collegiate Regattas. Race Committee reserves the right to rule on whether foreign entries are appropriately seeded within the Club event.

**Senior Veteran:** At least 70 years old.

**Veteran:** At least 60 years old.

**Grand Master:** At least 50 years old.

**Senior Master:** At least 40 years old.

**Master (singles):** At least 30 years old.

**Master (crew):** Rowers' ages average at least 40 years, no one except coxswain under 30 years old.

**Master 50+:** Rowers' ages average at least 50 years, no one except coxswain under 30 years old.

**Youth:** Persons (coxswain included) under 20 years old and not yet in their sophomore (2nd) year of college/university.

**High School:** A crew composed entirely of students under 19 years old from a single High School.

**Lightweight (singles):** Maximum weights: Men: 160 lbs. Women: 130 lbs.

**Lightweight (crew):** Men: Average of rowers' weights not to exceed 160 lbs., no one over 170 lbs. Women: Average of rowers' weights not to exceed 130 lbs., no one over 138 lbs.

**Championship:** Open (unrestricted).

**Men's divisions:** Male rowers and scullers only.

**Women's divisions:** Female rowers and scullers only.

**Coxswains:** May be of either sex, but must carry sufficient weight on them in the boat to weigh at least 100 lbs. during entire race (no weigh-in).

**Fours and Eights:** Sweep-oared, with coxswain.

**Singles and Doubles:** Sculling, no coxswain.

## AWARDS AND TROPHIES

**Louis Hawes Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Men's Club Singles in memory of Louis B. Hawes, long time Chair of Cambridge Boat Club's Rowing Committee and President of the New England Amateur Rowing Association.

**Peggy Hawes Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Women's Club Singles in honor of Margaret E. M. Hawes, inspiring founder of the Cambridge Boat Club's children's rowing program.

**Olrich Bowl:** Presented to the winner of the Men's Veteran Singles in memory of Jerome Olrich, twelve-time Head Of The Charles winner and key participant in the Regatta's development.

**Wade Trophy:** Presented to the highest placing Men's Senior Veteran in memory of Leonard "Zeus" Wade, key contributor to early Head Of The Charles regattas and long-time Senior Veteran standout.

**Witte Trophy:** Presented to the highest placing Women's Senior Veteran singles in memory of Edward and Eleanor Witte, beloved senior rowing members of the Cambridge Boat Club.

**MDC Cup:** Presented to the most competitive (percent behind the winner) Massachusetts high school crew by the Commissioner of the Metropolitan District Commission.

**Mowatt Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Men's Grand Master Singles in memory of H.H. "Mo" Mowatt, long time friend of the Head Of The Charles.

**Coleman Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Men's Lightweight Fours in memory of Charles Coleman, inspiring lightweight rower at St. Paul's and Yale and early supporter of the Head Of The Charles.

**City of Cambridge Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Women's Lightweight Fours by the Mayor of the City of Cambridge.

**Boston Herald Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Men's Lightweight Eights by the publisher of the Boston Herald.

**Boston Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Women's Lightweight Eights by the Mayor of the City of Boston.

**Arlett Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Men's Lightweight Singles in honor of George Ernest Arlett, key advisor to the founders of the Head Of The Charles.

**Singer Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Women's Lightweight Singles in honor of Edward Singer, the starting line "voice" of the Head Of The Charles for its first 20 years.

**Cromwell Trophy:** Presented to the winner of the Men's Championship Double in memory of Seymour Cromwell, national and international sculling champion and member of the Cambridge Boat Club.

**Swayze Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Women's Championship Doubles in honor of Craig Swayze, former president of the St. Catharines Rowing Club and key promoter of Canadian participation in the Head Of The Charles.

**Schaefer Cup:** Presented annually to the winner of the Men's Championship Fours.

**Barnes Plate:** Presented to the winner of the Women's Championship Fours in memory of Hope Barnes, former captain of the US Women's Olympic Rowing Team and two-time winner of the Head Of The Charles.

**Curtis Trophy:** Presented to the winner of the Men's Championship Singles in memory of the Hon. Lawrence Curtis, inspiring Cambridge Boat Club sculler, war hero, and US Congressman.

**Cambridge Boat Club Plate:** Presented to the winner of the Women's Championship Singles by the Board of Directors of the Cambridge Boat Club.

**Boston Globe Trophy:** Presented to the winner of the Men's Championship Eights by the publisher of the Boston Globe.

**Governor's Cup:** Presented to the winner of the Women's Championship Eights by the Governor of Massachusetts.

**Sportsmanship Award:** Presented (when earned) to crews and single scullers who demonstrate exemplary sportsmanship.

**D'Arcy MacMahon Crew Point Trophy:** Presented annually to the institution whose crews compile the highest aggregate point total.

**1st Place Medals:** Awarded to the winning single sculler or members of the winning crew in both the men's and women's divisions of each event.

**Subsidiary Medals:** Awarded to runner-up single scullers or members of the runner-ups in both the men's and women's division of each event. The number of medals awarded in each division is determined by the number of entrants in each division. A subsidiary medal is awarded per every 10 entrants.

**Special medals:** Awarded to the most competitive (% behind winner) male and female Youth sculler in the regatta, the fastest crew composed entirely of students under 19 years old from a single High School in each division of Events 6 and 8, and the fastest master crew averaging at least 50 years old in each division of Events 9, 10 and 12. Special medals will not be awarded to winners of regular medals.

**Paul Revere Point Trophy**

Presented annually to the institution whose crews compile the highest aggregate point total based on the following formula for each crew (not affected by single scullers):  $100/[1 + 50(c/w-1)]$  where  $c$  = the crew's time and  $w$  = the winner's time.

*Please note:* all subsidiary and special medals are ordered and engraved after the event and will be mailed to medal winners by January.

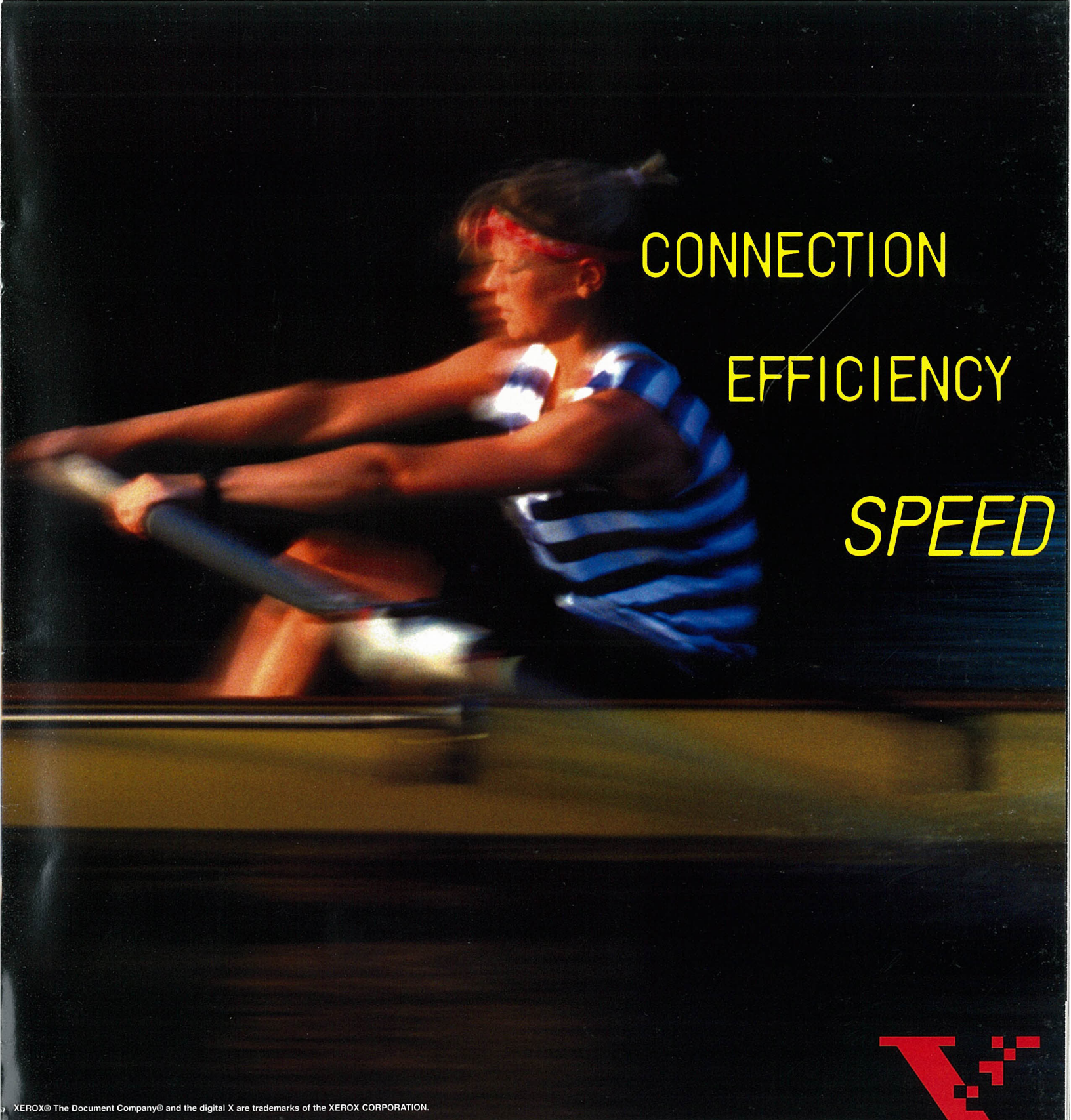
In Brookline, 59 companies shelled out a whopping 16.3 million dollars to have the noted designation of "sponsor" linked to the biennial golf match. The mini-

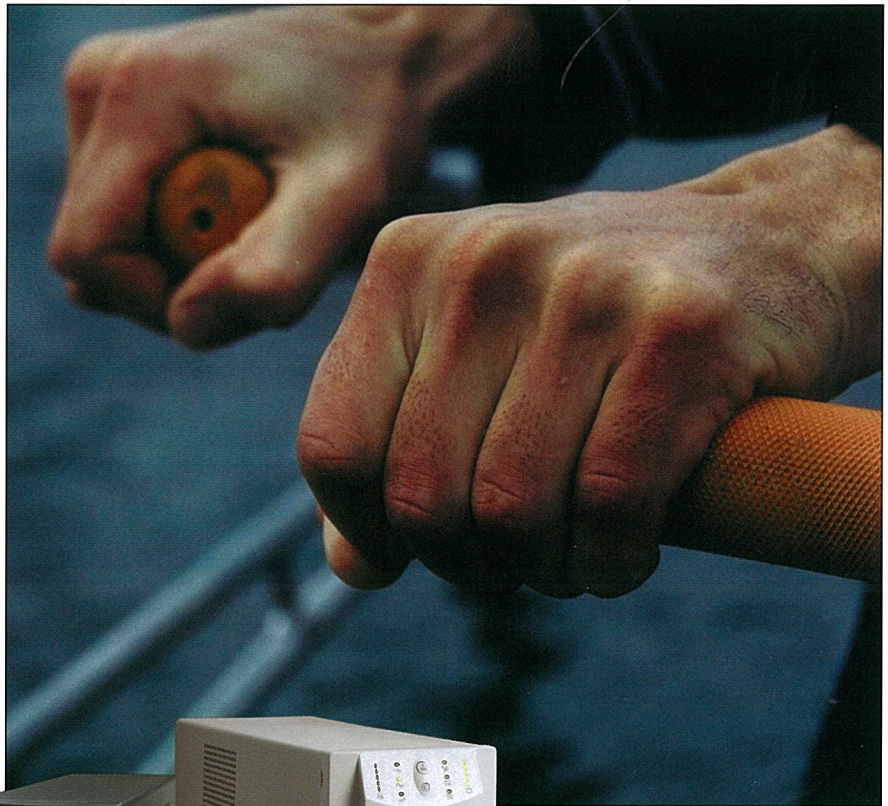

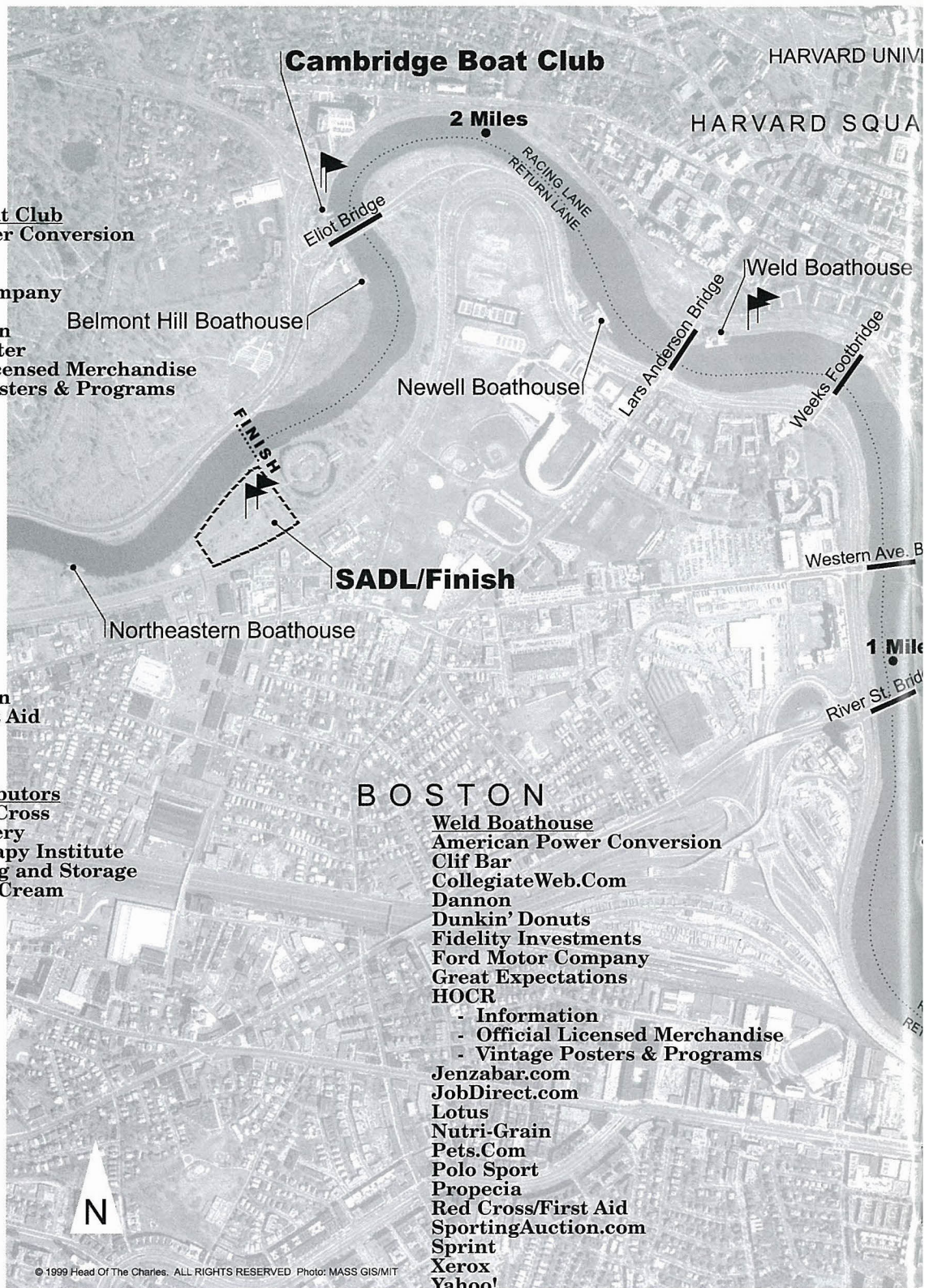

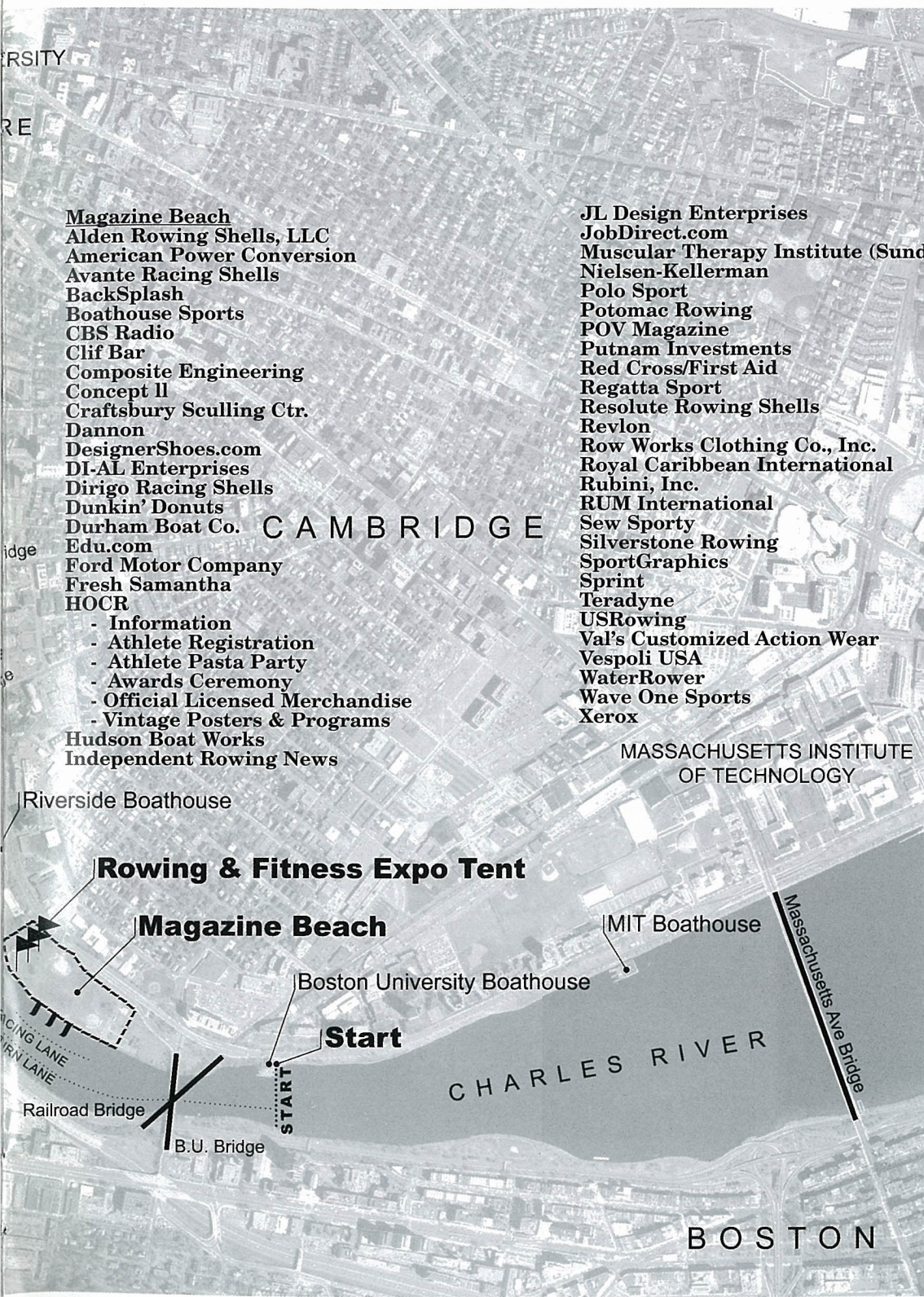
