

On behalf of the Regatta's Board of Directors, seventy-person Race Operations group, Co-Race Directors Alan I scher and Tom Tiffany, over 1,000 volunteers and the event's founding instrution, the Cambridge Boat Club, I welcome you to the 41st edition of the Heat Of The Charles.

The Regatta introduces three new race events this weekend. We have added the Collegiate Four event on Saturday, to build upon the successful Collegiate Eights category. A new race for Collegiate/Youth Doubles has also been added on Sunday. It is our hope that by providing an opportunity for early-stage scullers, we enhance the future of sculling worldwide. We have also created the Directors' Challenge Quad event on Sunday afternoon. This challenging charity event is for skilled scullers only, whose fees will directly contribute to the Regatta's permanent endowment that ensures the longevity of the Head Of The Charles.




IN MEMORIAM - SHERRY C. PROCTOR 1925-2005

This year we celebrate the life of Sherry Proctor, a twenty-five year veteran Head Of The Charles Regatta volunteer, Chairperson of the Course Committee, former competitor, and dear friend. Whilst working as an architect in Cambridge, Sherry began sculling at Weld Boathouse in the early 1970's by enrolling in an adult rowing class. He continued to scull daily by coming down to the Boathouse during the noon hour weeks after the class had ended. He sculled that way for nearly two seasons undetected, probably due to his "professorial appearance" and unassuming air. He was finally "discovered," banished from Weld, and having met many CBC members on the water migrated to Cambridge Boat Club.

He rowed competitively for the Club for many years and took to heart the sense of community the Cambridge Boat Club has, working on architectural renovations and repairing boats and blades over the years. He began volunteering for the HOCR early on. . He designed the course map and boat graphics for the early HOCR programs and even bow numbers, silk screening them at his home. He never lost his enthusiasm for the graphics but found himself drawn to the water (of course) and took on the challenge of setting the course which began a long relationship with HOCR serving on the Course Committee. Back then, it was a casual affair, the course consisted of Clorox bottles anchored with bricks. All the bricks had to be tied onto the bottles by hand. It was time-consuming, so Sherry devised a much more efficient method. Today, the river bottom is "sounded" and over 300 fluorescent orange buoys are clipped to anchors deployed at measured distances apart, with elastic tethers of specified length, depending on the river depth. All the buoys and related anchors have been designed to be stored with the minimum of space and the most ease of handling. The swiftness and apparent ease in deployment is extraordinarily elegant. Economical but also beautiful.

Infused with the enthusiasm for rowing, Sherry, together with other members formed Community Rowing, Inc.(CRI) in 1984 to provide the public with a chance to learn to row on the Charles. He designed the distinctive logo and letterhead, the oar blades, and the first brochures. After the organization began to grow, the search began for a site that





would allow access to the river and protection for their boats. He recognized the excellent opportunities afforded by the Daly skating rink and spent countless hours attending meetings seeking MDC (now DCR) approval. He designed the cover for the arena, and when additional boat storage was needed, he designed the building for them too. His genius in design and detail resulted not only in a structure that was inexpensive to build but one that was built over three weekends by eager volunteers and the leftover scrap material fitting into a single trash barrel! Although designed to be temporary, it is still in use twenty years later. Sherry was notably embarrassed when it was named the "Proctor Boathouse."

Learning to row sweep can be a difficult task in an eight, so Sherry went on to design a new training barge for CRI too. This vessel provides a safe, stable platform on the river for beginning oarsmen to learn the elements of the stroke. It was designed to be built of ultralight materials which allows for easy launching and portability. Sherry shared his plans with other organizations which has enabled them to build and use barges for their own rowing programs.

Sherry's enthusiasm for rowing was not limited to the Charles. He volunteered with the C.R.A.S.H.B Sprints World Indoor Rowing Championships, and assisted Trans-Atlantic Rowing Challenge, a manpowered rowing race from Tenerife to Barbados. He contributed many hours fine-tuning engineering details like modifying the oars for the unique boat design and use in high seas. He flew with the team to the Canary Islands to ready the vessel for the journey, and was waiting for them at the finish less than two months later.

Sherry's interests were diverse and his contributions to CRI, CBC, C.R.A..S.H. B, HOCR and his family will not soon be forgotten. A tribute sculpture is being created commemorating his contribution to the HOCR course and will be placed as the starting line marker on the Boston Shore opposite the Boston University Boathouse when it is completed. Each competitor in the years to come will commence their race past this sculpture - a fitting tribute to the volunteer who worked so hard to make the HOCR Course the best it could be. Thank you, Sherry.

ARLETT CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Lightweight Singles, in memory of George Ernest Arlett, British "head-of-the-river" rowing enthusiast and key advisor to the founders of the Head of the Charles Regatta.

BARNES PLATE: Presented annually to the winner of Women's Championship Fours, in memory of Hope Barnes, two-time Head Of The Charles gold-medallist, captain of the U. S. Women's Olympic Rowing Team and a member of the Cambridge Boat Club family.

BOSTON CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Women's Lightweight Eights, by the City of Boston, in honor of its role as "Co-host City" of the Head Of The Charles Regatta.

BOSTON GLOBE TROPHY: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Championship Eights, by the Publisher and editorial staff of the Boston Globe, in honor of its inaugural sponsorship and continuing support of the Head Of The Charles Regatta.

BOSTON HERALD CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Lightweight Eights, by the Publisher and editorial staff of the Boston Herald, in honor of the worldwide attention brought to the Boston community by the Head Of The Charles Regatta

CAMBRIDGE BOAT CLUB PLATE: Presented annually to the winner of Women's Championship Singles, by the Directors of the Cambridge Boat Club, in recognition of the Club's leading role in the development of women's sculling

CAMBRIDGE CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Women's Lightweight Fours, by the City of Cambridge, in honor of its role as "Co-host City" of the Head Of The Charles Regatta

COLEMAN CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Lightweight Fours, in memory of Charles P. Coleman, inspiring member of St. Paul's School and Yale University crews and prominent early supporter of the Head Of The Charles Regatta.

CROMWELL TROPHY: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Championship Doubles, in memory of Seymour "Sy" Cromwell, worldrenowned sculling champion, Head Of The Charles enthusiast, and highly respected leader of the greater Boston rowing community.

CROSBY CUP: Presented annually to the Grand-Veteran sculler that posts the most competitive (ratio to fastest) time in Senior Veteran Singles, in memory of Thomas E. Crosby, for decades, perennially the Head Of The Charles Regatta's senior-most competitor.

CURTIS TROPHY: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Championship Singles, in memory of the Honorable Lawrence Curtis, courageous and inspiring Cambridge Boat Club sculler, war hero and member of U. S. Congress.

DCR CUP: Presented annually to the Massachusetts high-school that posts the most competitive (ratio to fastest) time in Youth Fours or Youth Eights, by the Department of Conservation and Recreation, in honor of the Cambridge Boat Club's contribution to local high-school rowing.

DUNCAN CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Youth Fours, in recognition of Roger and Mary Duncan's outstanding contribution to New England interscholastic rowing and to the inspiration they gave to early developers of the Head Of The Charles Regatta.

GOVERNOR'S CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Women's Championship Eights, by the Office of the Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in honor of the international acclaim brought to the Commonwealth by the Head Of The Charles Regatta.

LOUIS HAWES CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Club Singles. in memory of Louis B. Hawes, long-time leader of the Cambridge Boat Club's rowing program and former President of the N. E. Amateur Rowing Association

MCINTYRE CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Club Eights, in memory of Howard D. McIntyre, MD, Cambridge Boat Club rowing program leader, co-founder and key launcher of the Head Of The Charles Regatta.

MOWATT CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Grand-Master Singles, in memory of H. H. "Mo" Mowatt, erstwhile Grand-Master competitor and long-time supporter of the Head Of The Charles Regatta.

OLRICH CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Veteran Singles, in memory of Jerome Olrich, twelve-time Head Of The Charles gold-medallist and leading "mover and shaker" in the Regatta's early growth and develop-

PEGGY HAWES CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Women's Club Singles, in honor of Margaret E. M. Hawes, inspiring and indomitable advocate for youth and recreational rowing at the Cambridge Boat Club.

PIERSON CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Women's Club Eights, in recognition of Gail Pierson Cromwell's years of service to the Cambridge Boat Club and her pioneering contribution to the growth and development of women's rowing in America.

REGATTA POINT TROPHY ("MACMAHON CUP"): Presented annually to the club, school, college or university that demonstrates overall rowing supremacy at the Head Of The Charles Regatta, in honor of D'Arcy G. MacMahon's role in the design and founding of the Regatta. The MacMahon Cup, shall be presented annually to the "non-national-team" institution (e.g., a club, school, college or university) that demonstrates overall supremacy at the Regatta, by compiling the highest number of points as determined by the following formula for each sweep-oared (Fours/Eights) entry: P=100 divided by [1 + 10(E/F - 1), where P = the number of Points awarded to the institution represented by the entry, E=the Entry's time, and F=the Fastest time in the Event-division in which the entry competed.

SCHAEFER CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Championship Fours, in honor of the broad and varied corporate support, which helped keep the Head Of The Charles Regatta afloat and thirsting for success during its embryonic years.

SINGER CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Women's Lightweight Singles, in honor of Edward Singer, national rowing advocate and, for twenty years, the distinguished Starting-Line "voice" of the Head of the Charles

SWAYZE CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Women's Championship Doubles, in memory of Craig Swayze, late President of St. Catharines (Ontario) Rowing Club and prominent instigator of perennial Canadian participation in the Head Of The Charles Regatta.

TALBOT CUP: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Master Fours, in memory of Samuel S. Talbot's selfless work on behalf of the Head Of The Charles Regatta, his omnipresent sense of humor, and his contribution to master rowing at the Cambridge Boat Club.


WADE TROPHY: Presented annually to the winner of Men's Senior-Veteran Singles, in memory of Leonard "Zeus" Wade, perennial Senior-Veteran standout and a driving force in the launching of the Head Of The Charles Regatta.

WITTE TROPHY: Presented annually to the winner of Women's Senior-Veteran Singles, in memory of Edward and Eleanor Witte, beloved leaders and members of the senior rowing community at the Cambridge Boat Club.

1ST PLACE MEDALS: Awarded to the winning single sculler or members of the winning crew in both the men's and women's divisions of each event.

SUBSIDIARY MEDALS: Awarded to runner-up single scullers or members of the runner-up crews in both men's and women's division of each event. The number of entrants in each division determines the number of medals awarded in each division. A subsidiary medal is awarded per every 10 entrants up to 5th place.

Please note: All subsidiary and special medals are ordered and engraved after the event and will be mailed to medal winners by January.



EVENTS SPECIFICATION

Club: Persons that, in any sculling or sweep-oared competition ("master/veteran" competition excepted), DID NOT: (A) in the current or preceding eight calendar years, finish among the top three places at the FISA World Championships or Olympic Games; (B) in the current or preceding five calendar years, compete at the FISA World Championships or Olympic Games; (C) in the preceding five calendar years, finish in first-place in a Championship Event-division at the Head of the Charles Regatta; (D) in the preceding calendar year, finish among the top five places in any Event-division at the Head of the Charles" Regatta; or (E) in the current calendar year, compete in the quarter-finals, semifinals or finals of the Henley Royal Regatta or of the Henley Women's Regatta, or finish among the top six places at any national team trials, national or international championships (e.g., "elite" events at the USRowing National Championships, Zurich World Cup, Pan-Am Games, FISA World Junior Championships, World Under 23 Regatta, Head of the River Race, etc.), Copley or Jessop-Whittier events at the San Diego CC, EARC or EAWRC Sprints, NCAA, PAC-10, IRA (except pairs), or finish among the top three places at the Canadian Henley Regatta ('junior' events excepted), or finish in first-place in a varsity-eight event at the Dad Vail Regatta or the ECAC National Invitational Collegiate Championships. NB: The Regatta reserves the right to rule on any competition situation not specifically

Collegiate (sweep events only): Bona fide undergraduate students enrolled at and representing accredited/chartered colleges or universities and eligible to compete in intercollegiate athletics* in accordance with NCAA Division I, II, or III rules, that DID NOT, in the current calendar year, (A) compete in Copley or Jessop-Whittier events at the San Diego CC; (B) compete in finals (grand or petite) at the EARC, EAWRC or Lexus Central Sprints, NCAA (Division I events only) or IRA Championships (except pairs); (C) finish among the top six places at the PAC-10 Championships, or (D) receive any rowing athletic-based scholarships of any kind.

*Applicants made up of bona fide undergraduate students enrolled at and representing accredited/chartered NON-US colleges or universities must contact the HOCR office before applying for Collegiate events in order to assess that they are properly placed in this event. The HOCR will make eligibility determinations for all foreign crews.

Collegiate/Youth Double: Collegiate: Bona fide undergraduate students enrolled at and representing accredited/chartered colleges or universities and eligible to compete in intercollegiate athletics in accordance with NCAA (or their nation's equivalent) rules. (Please note, the Collegiate 2X does NOT follow the same rules as the Collegiate sweep events. The Collegiate 2X is an open event.) Youth: Competitors must have completed their sophomore year of high school. The rowers do NOT need to be from the same high school. (Collegiate entrants will start before Youth entrants.)

(Note: Age Restrictions stipulated are as of race day, in number of whole years lived)

Grand-Veteran (singles): At least 75 years old (special medal).

Senior-Veteran (singles): At least 70 years old. Veteran (singles): At least 60 years old.

Grand-Master (singles): At least 50 years old.
Senior-Master (singles): At least 40 years old.

Master (singles): At least 30 years old.

Youth (singles): Under 20 years old and not yet in their Sophomore (2nd) year of college/university (special medal).

Senior-Master (doubles): Scullers' ages average at least 50 years, neither under 30 years.

Master (doubles): Scullers ages average at least 40 years, neither under 30 years old.

Senior-Master (crews): Rowers ages average at least 50 years, no one except coxswain under 30 years old.

Master (crews): Rowers ages average at least 40 years, no one except coxswain under 30 years old.

Youth (crews): Persons (coxswain included) under 20 years old and not yet in their Sophomore (2nd) year of college/university.

Lightweight (singles): Maximum weights: Men: 160lbs; Women: 130lbs.

Lightweight (crew): Men: Average of rowers' weights not to exceed 160lbs, no-one over 170lbs; Women: Average of rowers' weights not to exceed 130 lbs, no-one over 138lbs.

Championship: Open (unrestricted).

Men's Divisions: Male rowers and scullers only.

Women's Divisions: Female rowers and scullers only.

Coxswains: May be of either sex, but must carry sufficient weight on them in the boat to weigh at least 100lbs during entire race (no weigh-in).

Fours and Eights (crews): Sweep-oared, with coxswain.

Singles and Doubles: Sculling, no coxswain.

In 1975, a group of amazing women rowed their way to international success and glory, battling sexual prejudice, bureaucracy, and male domination in one of the most grueling and competitive sports around.
